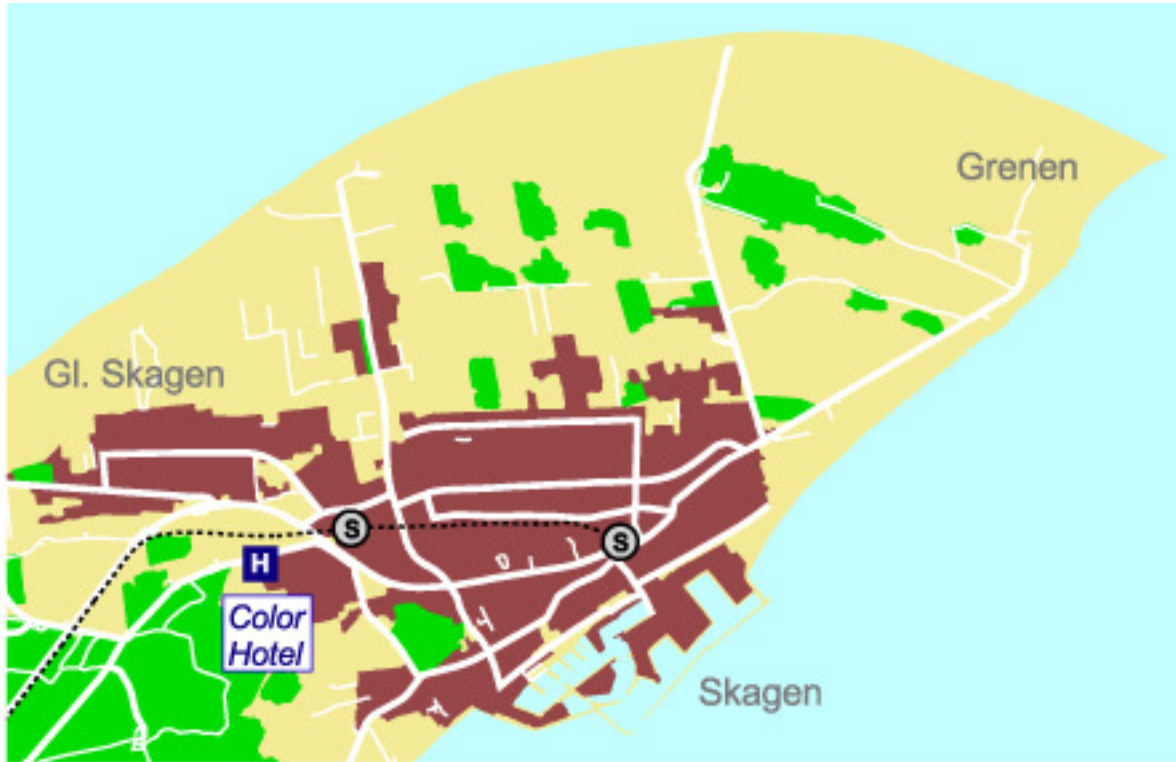

3. Getting to the Color Hotel Skagen



3.1 Transportation to and from Color Hotel and Skagen Railway Station.

You have to be aware that there is a little way station called Frederikshavnsvej only five minutes walk from Color Hotel. Then you do not need to go to Skagen Station and then by taxi back to the hotel.

3.2 Bigger groups

3.3 Travelling

By Air:

Aalborg Airport: www.aal.dk is the nearest major airport to Skagen and is 1¼ hours drive away (105 km). There are flights from Copenhagen and Oslo. There is a bus service between the airport and the nearest Railway Station (5 min. away). The station is called Lindholm Station and is a small way station. It might be easier to get a taxi to the Lindholm Station. Taxis are just outside the airport. Some of the trains only stop at Aalborg Railway Station (15 minutes by taxi). The train to Frederikshavn is 1 hour and 10 minutes and then the Skagen Train is 36 minutes more. When you get to Skagen you must be aware that there is a little way station called **Frederikshavnsvej** only five minutes walk from Color Hotel. Then you do not need to go to Skagen Station and then by taxi back to the hotel.

For train timetables see www.rejseplanen.dk. **Also in English!** Or ask your travel agent.

Aarhus Airport: www.aar.dk is 2 hours and 41 minutes drive and 242 km away from Skagen. There are flights from Oslo, Gothenburg, Stockholm, London and Copenhagen. Bus to Randers (60 minutes) or to Aarhus (45 minutes). Or get a taxi. From Randers or Aarhus by train to Skagen. (It is advisable to go to Randers. But the bus is not as frequent as it is to Aarhus). Train from Randers to Skagen is 2 hours and 55 minutes. From Aarhus it is 3 hours and 27 minutes. When you get to Skagen you must be aware that there is a little way station called **Frederikshavnsvej** only five minutes walk from Color Hotel. Then you do not need to go to Skagen Station and then by taxi back to the hotel. Please check timetables with your travel agent.

Billund Airport: www.billund-airport.dk is 3 hours and 22 minutes drive and 316 km away. Flights from Stavanger, Bergen, Oslo, Edinburgh, Manchester, London, Amsterdam and Brussels. Bus or taxi to Vejle (the nearest Railway Station) is 30 minutes. Or bus to Aarhus 1 hour and 45 minutes or Randers 2 hours and 35 minutes. Train from Vejle to Skagen is 4 hours and 19 minutes. When you get to Skagen you must be aware that there is a little way station called **Frederikshavnsvej** only five minutes walk from Color Hotel. Then you do not need to go to Skagen Station and then by taxi back to the hotel. Please check timetables with your travel agent.

Esbjerg Airport: www.esbjerg-lufthavn.dk is 3 hours and 41 minutes drive and 370 km away. Flights from Stavanger and Aberdeen. to Esbjerg Railway Station or Bus Station is 20 minutes. Bus 980 from the airport to Frederikshavn and then by train or bus to Skagen is 5 hours and 40 minutes. Train to Skagen is app. 6 hours. When you get to Skagen you must be aware that there is a little way station called **Frederikshavnsvej** only five minutes walk from Color Hotel. Then you do not need to go to Skagen Station and then by taxi back to the hotel.

Copenhagen Airport: www.cph.dk is 408 km and five hours by car away. There are frequent connection flights to Aalborg. Train is appr. 6 hours and 45 minutes to Skagen. There are long distance buses from Copenhagen to Aalborg www.bus888.dk. Bus to Frederikshavn and then further to Skagen is more than 7 hours. When you get to Skagen you must be aware that there is a little way station called **Frederikshavnsvej** only five minutes walk from Color Hotel. Then you do not need to go to Skagen Station and then by taxi back to the hotel.

By ferry to:

For ferry Lines: <http://www.directferries.dk>.

Hirtshals: Ferries from Stavanger, Bergen, Kristiansand and Larvik. Hirtshals to Skagen is 45 minutes drive and 50 km away. Bus to Skagen 1 hours and 38 min. Different lines are available. Please check on the ferry.

Frederikshavn: Ferries from Oslo and Gothenburg. 30 minutes and 30 km away. See below for train and bus connections.

Grenå – Varberg: 246 km drive and 2 hours and 51 minutes away. Bus to Randers and then by train to Skagen is 4 hours. You can also get a long distance bus from Grenå.

Esbjerg – Harwich: For train and bus connections see under Esbjerg Airport above.

Please check connection timetables on the ferries.

By Train or bus:

As explained in the section above you can travel by train or bus from the airports and harbours. All trains stop in Frederikshavn which also is the end station. But then you have to go further on with the train to Skagen the last half hour. You can also travel by bus from Frederikshavn if you prefer. The train from Frederikshavn to Skagen takes 36 minutes. If travelling by rail you have to be aware when you enter Skagen that there is a little way station called **Frederikshavnsvej** only five minutes walk from Color Hotel. Then you do not need to go to Skagen Station and then by taxi back to the hotel.

By Car (self-drive):

From Frederikshavn

30 minutes and 30 km away from Skagen. Follow route 40 to Skagen. When you enter Skagen you are on Frederikshavnvej. Turn right on Flagbakkevej (Towards the sand buried church) and left onto Gl. Landevej where Color Hotel is situated.

From Hirtshals

45 minutes away and 50 km. Follow highway E39 and then turn to route 597 via Ålbæk and then turn left on route 40 to Skagen. When you enter Skagen you are on Frederikshavnvej. Turn right on Flagbakkevej (Towards the sand buried church) and left onto Gl. Landevej where Color Hotel is situated.
